Import Configuration with CLI

Windows Command Line (CMD)

```
"%ProgramFiles%\Fortinet\FortiClient\FCConfig.exe" ^  
-m all ^  
-f "<Path-to-Configuration-File>" ^  
-o import ^  
-i 1 ^  
-p "<Password>"
```

Windows PowerShell

```
& "$env:ProgramFiles\Fortinet\FortiClient\FCConfig.exe" `  
-m all `  
-f "<Path-to-Configuration-File>" `  
-o import `  
-i 1 `  
-p "<Password>"
```

Export Configuration with CLI

Windows Command Line (CMD)

```

-m vpn ^  
-f "<Path-to-exported-File>" ^  
-o export ^  
-p "<Password>"
```

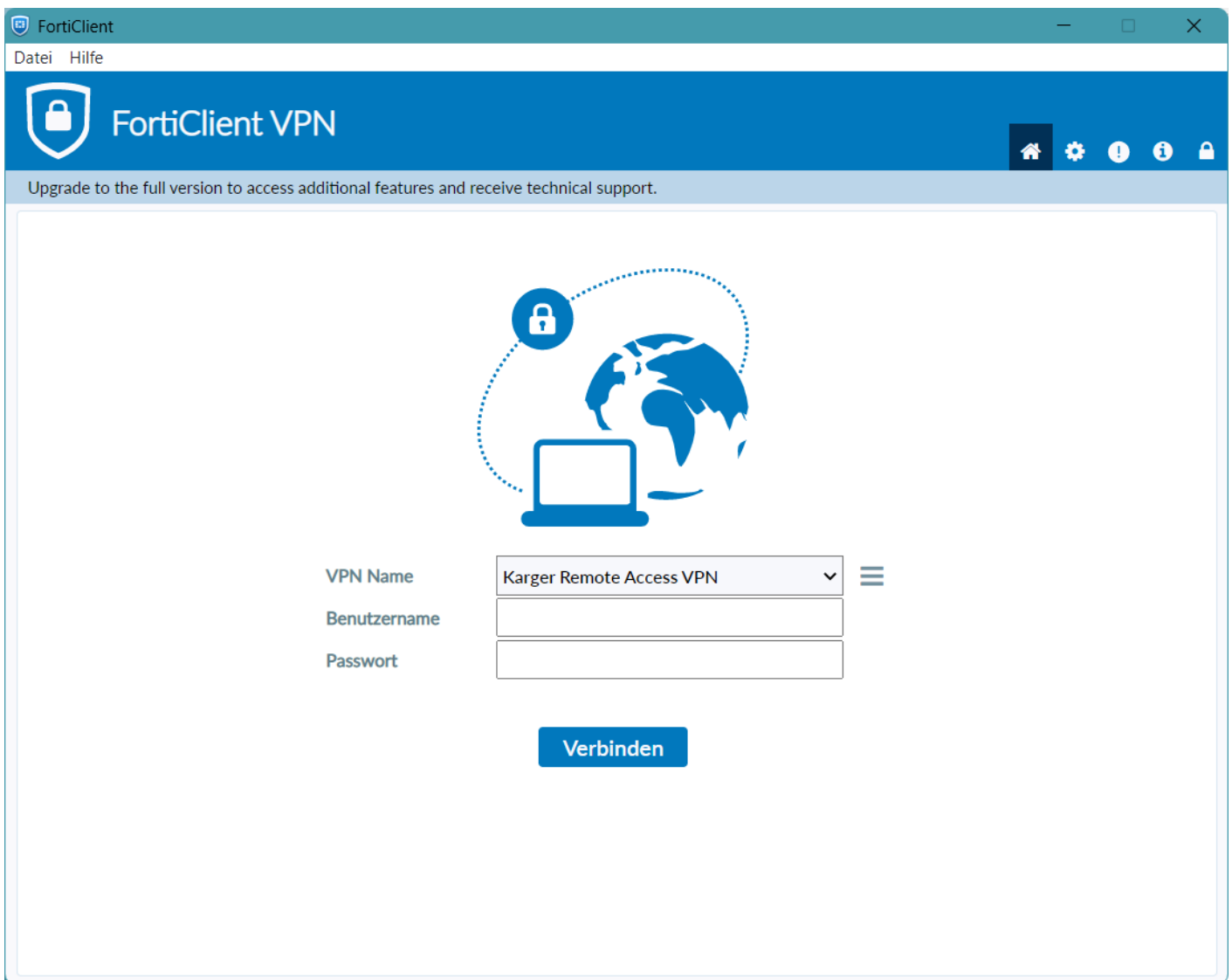

```

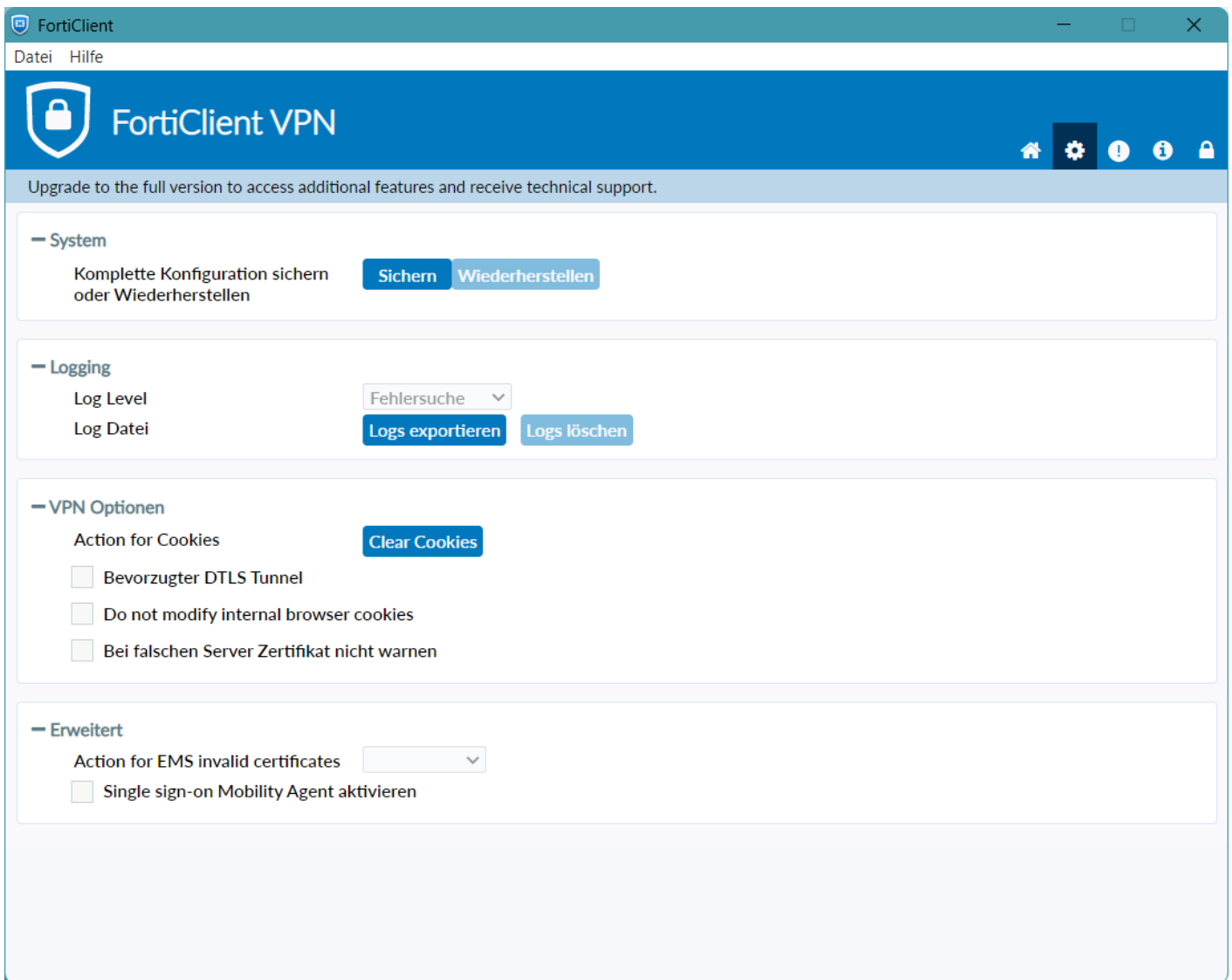
Import/Export with GUI

Launch “FortiClient” after installing

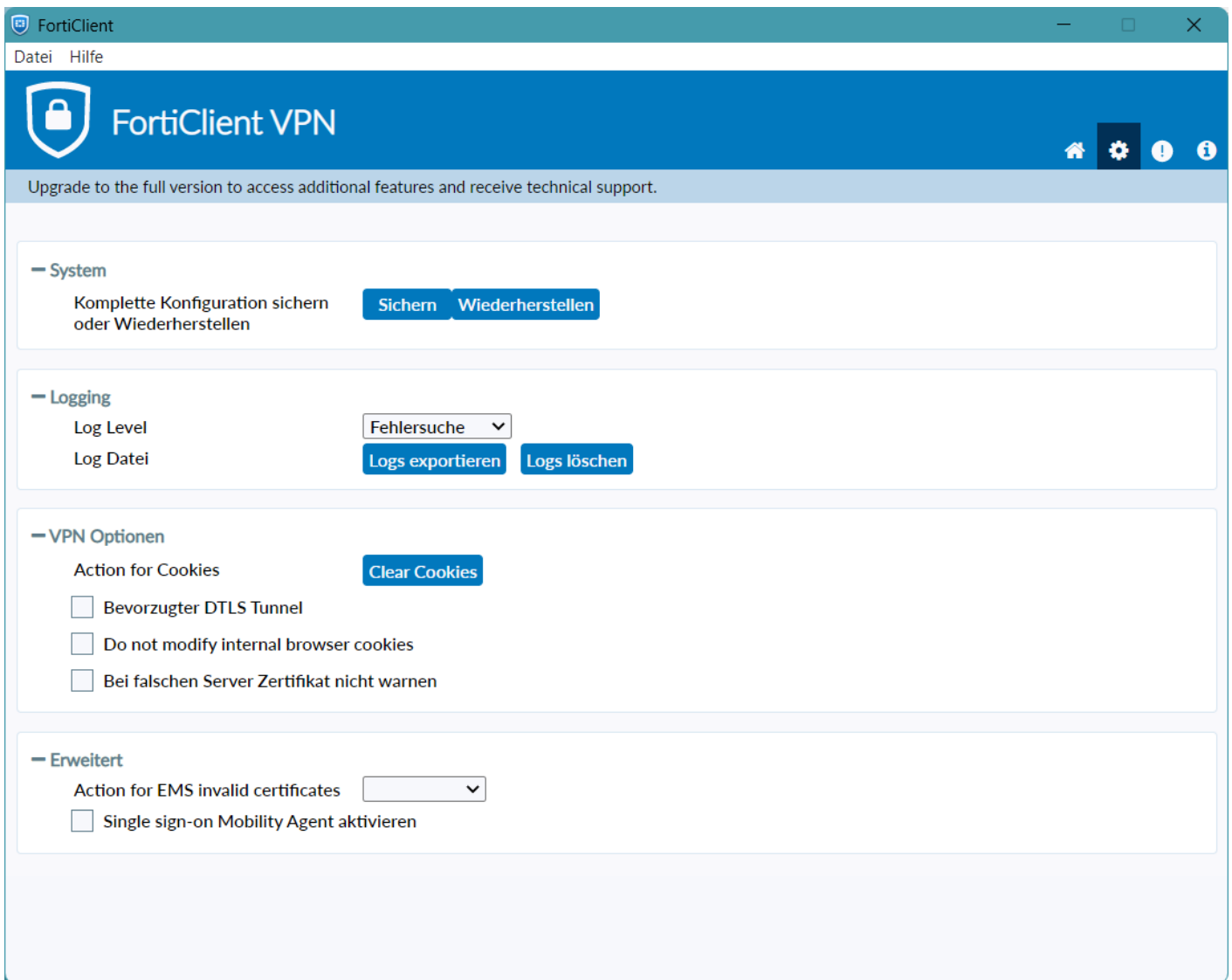


Click on the “Cog” Icon in the top right corner

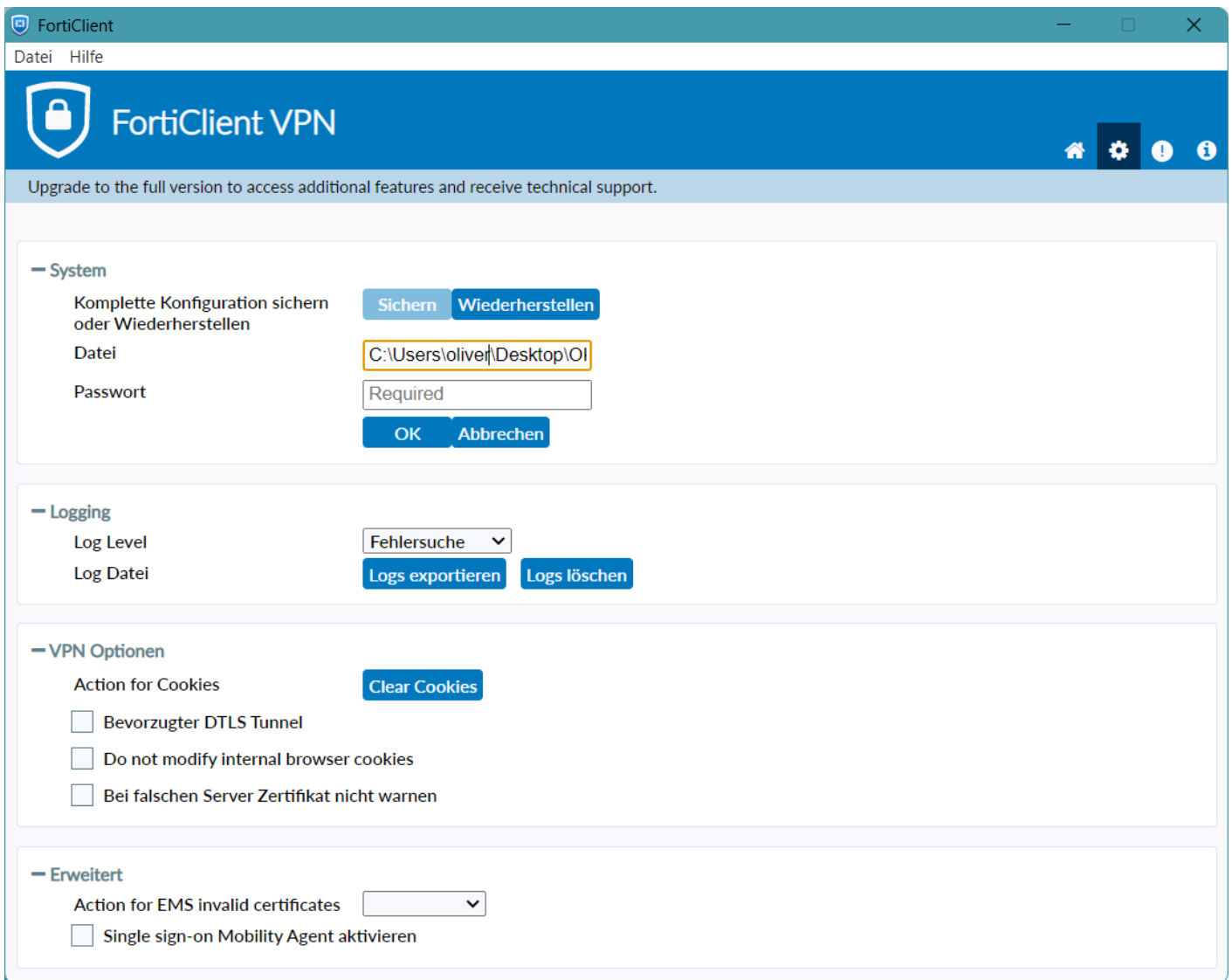


Click on the "Lock" icon in the top left corner to unlock the System Configuration Import ("Wiederherstellen" Button the the Screenshot)
